Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.40 dated 06.07.2024 under Sections 22/61/85 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 (Section 29 of the NDPS was added later on) registered at Police Station Singh Bhagwantpur, District Rupnagar.

Vide order dated 03.12.2024, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in pursuance to the order passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation and as such his interim bail may be made absolute.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI, Suresh Kumar has stated that petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, interim order dated 03.12.2024 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) of BNSS, 2023.

Petition stands allowed.
