1. The present petition has been filed by the petitioner seeking grant of interim bail in a criminal case having FIR No.126 dated 23.08.2024 under Sections 21 and 29 NDPS Act and 25 of Arms Act, Police Station Special Task Force, SAS Nagar Mohali, on the ground that FSL report is still awaited.

2. During the pendency of the present petition, the counsel for the petitioner brought to the notice of the Court that the petitioner is suffering from fracture of left leg for which he is being not provided proper medical treatment by the jail authorities and as such, be given concession of interim bail on medical grounds.

3. Medical status report filed by the State counsel in compliance of the earlier order of this Court is taken on record.

4. As per the medical opinion given by the Board of Doctors, the petitioner was operated case of fracture shaft tibia left side with implant in



situ which is about 6 and a half month old. Fracture is still uniting with difficulty in walking with tenderness over lower part of back of left leg with mild impinging of distal AP screw of implant with decrease in knee flexion (20 to 30 degree) with muscle power 4/5 of left lower limb. He is advised to avoid squatting and starting up and down and crosslegged position and advised walk with support and further advised follow up in the ortho OPD after one month.

5. In the light of the aforesaid medical opinion given by Board of Doctors, it is apparent that petitioner suffered fracture shaft tibia left side for which he was treated but even now, he is facing difficulty in walking properly without support and is also advised to avoid squatting and starting up and down and crosslegged position.

6. In the light of the aforesaid medical condition of the petitioner, the present petition is hereby disposed of and petitioner is granted interim bail for a period of 6 weeks from the date of his release, subject to satisfaction of the CJM/Duty Magistrate concerned. The petitioner is to surrender immediately on the expiry of the aforesaid period of 6 weeks which is to be notified by the Court concerned in its release order.
