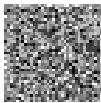

SUDEEPTI SHARMA, J. (Oral)

1. The contempt petition has been filed for deliberate and intentional disobedience of order dated 29.05.2025 passed in CWP-16717-2025, whereby, direction was issued to the respondents to decide the legal notice dated 06.05.2025 and if the petitioner is found entitled, the respondents were directed to grant all the benefits forthwith.
2. Learned counsel for respondents-State contends that order dated 29.05.2025 passed in CWP-16717-2025 has been complied with. This fact is not disputed by learned counsel for the petitioner.
3. In view of the same, the contempt is purged and rule is discharged.
