Learned counsel for the respondents relies upon an order dated 13.01.2025 passed by the respondent(s), whereby it has been found that the petitioner is entitled for interest @ 6% on the retiral benefits except on the amount of LTC. He, on instructions from Mr. Shashi Gagg, Assistant Registrar (Legal), Office of DSE (SE), Punjab, who is present in Court, submits that amount due to the petitioner towards 6% interest shall be released within a period of two days from today.

[2] In view of the above undertaking, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the present petition any further.
