HARKESH MANUJA J. (Oral)

1. Reply filed on behalf of respondent No.1 in Court today, is taken on record.
2. Learned counsel for respondent No.1 informs that the calculation in terms of order passed by this Court in first appeal has been forwarded by the Competent Authority for Land Acquisition (CALA) and the approval thereupon has already been received. He further submits that the amount of compensation as a consequence thereof shall be deposited with the Executing Court within a period of 04 weeks from today upon due verification of the calculation, so that the same can be released to the petitioner.
3. In view of the above, learned counsel for petitioner does not want to press the present petition.

4. Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed being not pressed. Rule stands discharged.

5. However, in case the needful is not done within the afore-stated period, the petitioner would be at liberty to seek revival of the present contempt petition and in that eventuality, the erring concerned officer(s) would be liable to pay additional sum of Rs.50,000/- as costs from his/her own pocket in favour of the petitioner towards litigation expenses, immediately, i.e. on the first date of listing of revival application.
