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SUMEET GOEL, J (ORAL)

1. The substantive prayer made in the petition reads as follows :-

“It is, therefore, respectfully, prayed that present petition may kindly be allowed and the appropriate directions may kindly be issued to official respondents to conduct proper, fair, impartial and expeditious investigation into the case FIR No. 0201 dated 15.12.2023 registered under Sections 323, 447, 148, 149 IPC (Sections 308, 325, 324 IPC added lateron) at PS Makhu, District Ferozepur (Annexure P-1), in accordance with the provisions of Sections 173 to 196 (Chapter XIII) of BNSS in order to bring the real culprits to book and to get them punished in accordance with law to secure the ends of justice;

2. Status report dated 10.09.2025 in the form of an affidavit of Bhupinder Singh, PPS, Senior Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur has been filed on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3-State. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof has been supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner.

3. Relevant portion thereof reads as under:-

“That on 07.04.2025, complainant Sardool Singh submitted an application to Director General of Police, Punjab, Chandigarh with the prayer to get the inquiry conducted out of Ferozepur Range, preferably from the police of District Mohali or District Chandigarh.

The said application was marked to AIG, Investigation, Director, Bureau of Investigation, Punjab, Chandigarh by Director General of Police, Punjab, Chandigarh to verify the investigation as per law and fact.

That on 09.04.2025, AIG, Investigation of Director, Bureau of Investigation, Punjab, Chandigarh asked the office of the deponent to send the case file of the present case through investigating officer of this case vide letter no.234-35/R/AIG/Investigation dated 09.04.2025 as the investigation was entrusted to him, so the case file of the present case was submitted to the office of AIG, Investigation, Director Bureau of Investigation, Punjab, Chandigarh on 10.04.2025 through ASI Pargat Singh no.1275 of P.S. Makhu. Now the investigation is being conducted/examined by AIG, Investigation, Director, Bureau of Investigation, Punjab, Chandigarh.

4. In view of the above, no directions are required to be issued in the present petition at this stage.
5. Disposed of accordingly.
