The present petition has been filed under Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for issuance of appropriate directions to respondents No.2 to 4 for entrustment of the investigation of G.D. No.007 dated 18.07.2024 (Annexure P-1) relating to unnatural death of Jaspreet Singh @ Jassa i.e. son of the petitioner on 15.07.2024 to independent agency/SIT comprising of higher rank police officer as no just, fair and impartial investigation/proceedings have been undertaken so far by the police.

The learned State counsel, at the very outset, submits that a specific opinion has been given by the Board of Doctors after going through the post mortem report as well as Chemical Examiners Report and it has been concluded that it is not a case of unnatural death, as such, there is no cause of action with the petitioner to invoke the jurisdiction of this Court. He further submits that the representation filed by the petitioner which is annexed with the present petition as Annexure P-4 has already been decided and consigned to record.

In view of the statement made by the learned State counsel, the present petition is disposed of and no further directions are required to be passed. However, liberty is granted to the petitioner to invoke his alternative appropriate remedy in accordance with law, if so advised.
