By way of present petition filed under Section 482 of BNSS, 2023, petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR (Annexure P-1) as under:

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance to the order dated 05.12.2024 passed by this Court, the petitioner has already joined the investigation and as such prayed for confirming the interim bail granted vide order dated 05.12.2024.

3. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Jarnail Singh, intimates the Court that the petitioner has joined investigation and is neither required for further investigation nor for any custodial interrogation.



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4. During the course of hearing on 05.12.2024, following order was passed:

“Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the dispute infact arose on account of the soil excavated from the fields of the petitioner in respect of which the complainant was required to make payment. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that, in any case, both the alleged injuries have been opined to be simple in nature and are not attributed to the petitioner but to the co-accused. Learned counsel submitted that the petitioner shall make efforts to amicably resolve the matter and come out with some concrete offer in this regard on the next date of hearing.

Meanwhile, in the event of arrest, the petitioner be released on interim bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and cooperate with the Investigating Officer and shall also abide by the conditions as provided under Section 482 BNSS. ”

5. Keeping in view the above submissions made by learned State counsel and the fact that the petitioner had joined the investigation consequent to the order dated 05.12.2024 passed by this Court, interim bail granted vide order dated 05.12.2024 is hereby confirmed, subject to conditions as envisaged under Section 482 (2) of BNSS, 2023. Further the petitioner is directed to join investigation as and when required in future by way of written notice for such purpose to be served by Investigating Officer of this case upon the petitioner; he will not tamper with the



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evidence nor will influence the witnesses and will not leave the country without prior permission of the Court.

- 6. The petition stands allowed.
- 7. It is made clear that anything contained hereinabove shall not be construed to be an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
