The petitioner has filed the instant petition under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.127 dated 14.11.2024 registered under Sections 115(2), 74, 351(1) & 351(3) of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 at Police Station Division No.7, Jalandhar.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that, in pursuance to the order dated 07.01.2025 passed by this Court, the petitioner has appeared before the Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

3. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Satpal Singh, has not disputed the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for further investigation.
