1. The instant criminal writ petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of Constitution of India seeking issuance of directions to respondent Nos.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners.

2. Status report dated 10.01.2025 by way of an affidavit of Surinder Pal, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Kartarpur, Jalandhar Rural, in compliance of order passed by this Court on 18.12.2024. The same is taken on record. A copy thereof has been supplied to learned counsel for the petitioners in the Court today itself.

3. Learned State counsel submits that as per the status report, the State has assessed the threat perception of the petitioners and similar statements of relevant private respondents have been recorded to the effect that they have never issued any threat to the petitioners till date and have not interfered in the life of the petitioners. As such, there is no threat to life and liberty of the

petitioners from anyone and further, the petitioners also got recorded their statements that they do not want any action on the basis of the present petition.

3. In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioners wishes to withdraw the present petition.
4. Dismissed as withdrawn.
