1. Prayer in the instant civil writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the order dated 16.04.2024 (Annexure P-7), passed by learned Commissioner, Hisar Division, Hisar; order dated 13.02.2019 (Annexure P-5), passed by learned Collector, Jind and order dated 08.08.2017 (Annexure P-3), passed by Assistant Collector 1st Grade/Sub Divisional Officer (Civil), Jind.

2. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for petitioner submits that he may be permitted to withdraw this writ petition with liberty to petitioner to avail his other remedies, in accordance with law; including seeking partition of land wherein respondents No. 5 and 6 have become co-owners on the strength of sale deed dated 05.12.2014, in regard to which mutation No. 2573 was sanctioned by the revenue authorities.
