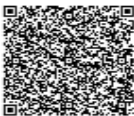

The petitioner has filed the present petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India with a prayer to issue directions to the respondents to grant 8 weeks parole to the petitioner, in view of the provisions contained in Section 3 (1) (d) of the Punjab Good Conduct Prisoners (Temporary Release) Act, 1962.

2. It has been pleaded that the prayer made by the petitioner for grant of parole is pending with the respondents, however, they have failed to take any conscious decision on various representations submitted by the petitioner.

3. Learned State counsel submits that the prayer made by the petitioner is pending with the respondents and a speaking order shall be



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passed within a period of two weeks from today by the competent authority.

4. In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, no further orders are required to be passed by this Court and the petition is accordingly disposed off.
