1. The instant petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 482 of Bhartiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.0104, dated 25.10.2024 registered under Section 498-A IPC at Police Station Sadar Gurdaspur, District Gurdaspur.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that, in pursuance to the order dated 05.12.2024 passed by this Court, the petitioner has appeared before the Investigation Officer and has joined the investigation.
