The jurisdiction of this Court has been invoked under section 483 (3) BNSS read with section 528 BNSS, praying for cancellation of anticipatory bail in FIR no. 58, (Annexure P-1) U/s 333, 127(2), 305, 329(3), 351(2), 62, 190, 191(3) BNS dated 26.08.2024 registered at police station: P.S Dhilwan, District Kapurthala, by setting aside impugned order dated 28.10.2024 (Annexure P-4) passed by the Ld. Addl. Sessions Judge, Kapurthala, granting bail to respondent no. 2.

In the present petition, the petitioner is seeking cancellation of anticipatory bail granted to respondent No.2 by the Addl. Sessions Judge, Kapurthala vide order dated 28.10.2024 (Annexure P-4). On previous occasion i.e. 04.02.2025, there was no representation on behalf of the petitioner.

On the last date of hearing, respondent No.2 would sought time to address arguments.

Today, no one has turned up on behalf of the petitioner to assist the Court in the matter.

In the light of above, this Court is of the considered view that the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant petition any further.

Hence, the same is dismissed for non-prosecution.
