The instant petition under Section 482 BNSS, 2023, has been filed for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.191, dated 21.09.2024, under Sections 420, 406, 120-B of IPC, 1860 registered at Police Station City Moga (Annexure P-1).

Status report filed by way of an affidavit of Ravinder Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police (City), Moga, District Moga, is taken on record.

This Court vide order dated 09.12.2024, granted the concession of interim bail to the petitioner, subject to his joining the investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance to the order dated 09.12.2024, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel does not controvert the said fact and on instructions from Inspector Gurpreet Singh further submits that custodial interrogation of the petitioner is not required.

Mr. Mudit Johar, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of the complainant and filed his vakalatnama, which is taken on record. He submits that the petitioner is not returning the amount to the complainant, therefore, prays for dismissal of the petition.

Considering the fact that the petitioner has alerady joined the investigation, as has been stated by learned State counsel on instructions from Inspector Gurpreet Singh, the order dated 09.12.2024 is made absolute.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of.
