The prayer in the present petition under Section 528 of BNSS, 2023 is for issuance of directions to the respondents to make a detailed enquiry from independent higher officials or by appointing a Special Investigation Team in case FIR No.0062 dated 14.04.2023 under Section 21 of the NDPS Act, Police Station City Rupnagar, District Rupnagar, Punjab Section 29 of the NDPS Act added later on and FIR No.0154 dated 01.08.2024 under Section 22 of the NDPS Act, Police Station Rupnagar, District Rupnagar, Punjab.



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2. The learned counsel for the State has filed a reply dated 30.07.2025 which is taken on record. As per the said reply, in FIR No.0062 dated 14.04.2023 (Annexure P-1) as many as 06 prosecution witnesses stand examined whereas in FIR No.0154 dated 01.08.2024 (Annexure P-2) 04 prosecution witnesses have been examined.

3. In view of the stage of the Trial, the question of appointing an Special Investigation Team to further investigate the aforesaid cases does not arise.

4. In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of.

5. Needless to say that the petitioner is at liberty to take all defences available to him during the course of Trial in each case or avail any other legal remedy available to him under the law.
