The petition has been filed seeking a direction to the respondents to provide adequate security to the petitioner and his family members keeping in view the firing incident dated 20.09.2024 regarding which FIR no. 0186 dated 20.09.2024 under Sections 109 (1) and 3 (5) of Bhartiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 and Section 25 of Arms Act, 1959, Annexure P-1, was also lodged.

2. Pursuant to the last order, a status report, dated 10.03.2025, by

way of an affidavit of Assistant Commissioner of Police Dinesh Kumar, HPS, has been filed on behalf of respondents no. 2 to 7. As per letter dated 20.12.2024, Annexure R-3, appended thereto, the Deputy Commissioner of Police has issued instructions to the Assistant Commissioner of Police as well as the concerned Station House Officer, which are to the following effect:

1. The Station House Officer, Sector-5 Police Station, Panchkula, and the In-charge, Police Post Sector-2, Panchkula, are directed to maintain patrols and surveillance at the residence of the complainant, Mr. Pardeep Chaudhary, Ex-MLA, Kalka, resident of H. No. 154, Sector-02, Panchkula. They must issue instructions to the police personnel deployed on PCR/Riders/Dial-112 to ensure proper monitoring and patrolling in the area. Additionally, they are to check these arrangements regularly.
2. The In-charge of PCR/Riders/Dial-112 and the personnel deployed on these duties are instructed to keep strict surveillance around the residence of Mr. Pardeep Chaudhary. If any suspicious information or situation arises, it should immediately be brought to the notice of their superiors.
3. The Assistant Commissioner of Police, Law & Order, Panchkula, is directed to periodically communicate with the complainant, Mr. Pardeep Chaudhary, regarding his security concerns. Further, the ACP must inspect and provide appropriate instructions to the Station House Officer, PCR/Riders/Dial-112 personnel, and others deployed on duty concerning their responsibilities.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner fairly submits that after 29.10.2024, the petitioner has not lodged any complaint to the police regarding any suspicious activity or threat to him or his family members' life

and liberty. At this stage, the petitioner will be satisfied in case the respondents are directed to remain bound by the instructions issued vide letter referred to above.

4. In view thereof, the petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to ensure compliance of instructions issued vide letter, dated 20.12.2024, to the officers concerned. Besides, in case of any threat in future to the petitioner or his family members’ life and liberty, he will be at liberty to bring it to the notice of the respondents, whereupon action in accordance with law be taken.
