1. Through the instant writ petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, a prayer is made issuance of a mandamus to issue a direction upon the respondents to withdraw/recall look out circular (LOC).
2. Today, learned Additional Solicitor General of India, has apprised this Court, that the LOC issued against the present petitioner has already been withdrawn.
3. On the other hand, learned State counsel has filed an affidavit dated 27.06.2025, by way of an affidavit of Ms. Swapan Sharma, Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana, on behalf of respondents no.1 to 4,

which is taken on record, with a copy thereof, supplied to learned counsel opposite.

4. In view of the specific averment made in affidavit (*supra*), and the statement suffered by learned Additional Solicitor General of India, the prayer, as made in the instant writ petition has been rendered infructuous.

5. **Dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.**
