The petitioner is seeking setting aside of the judgment of conviction and order of sentence both dated 23.01.2020 passed by learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Malout, whereby the petitioner has been convicted for offence under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881 and sentenced to undergo RI for 02 years and to pay fine of ₹500/-, and the order dated 05.11.2024 passed by learned Sessions Judge, Sri Muktsar Sahib, vide which the appeal preferred by the petitioner was partly allowed whereby conviction of the petitioner was upheld, however, his sentence was reduced to RI for 01 year.

2. Vide order dated 21.04.2025, the parties were directed to appear before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court for exploring the possibility of an amicable settlement.

3. In compliance of the order dated 21.04.2025, report from



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the Mediation and Conciliation Centre has been received. As per report, the parties have settled their dispute by way of an amicable settlement/agreement.

4. In view of the report received from the Mediation and Conciliation Centre to which the parties were referred to and the compromise/settlement, annexed as Annexure-A, the instant revision petition stands disposed of in terms of the compromise/settlement.

5. Pending applications, if any, stand disposed of.
