The instant contempt petition alleges disobedience of order dated 11.07.2024 (Annexure P-1) passed in CRM-M-25465-2024;

“2. In the light of the above and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the present petition is hereby disposed of with direction to respondent No.2 to consider and decide representation dated 04.05.2022 (Annexure P-1) submitted by the petitioner, in accordance with law within a period of two months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.”

- 3. No one has appeared on behalf of the petitioners to press the present contempt petition.

- 5. The contempt petition is accordingly disposed of. Rule stands discharged.
