1. This petition has been filed under Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 seeking quashing of FIR No.18 dated 01.03.2023 under Sections 454/380 of IPC (Sections 420/34 of IPC added later on) registered at Police Station Talwara, District Hoshiarpur (Annexure P-1) along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 25.03.2023 (Annexure P-2).

2. The following order was passed on 10.01.2025:-

“CRM-479-2025

The present application has been filed under Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for amendment of the memo of parties by impleading Prabhleen Kaur wife of Aman as respondent No.3 in the main petition.

Notice in the application.

Mr. Subhash Godara, Addl.A.G., Punjab puts in appearance and accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.1-State and submits that he has



no objection if the present application is allowed.

In view of the averments made in the application, the same is allowed and Prabhleen Kaur wife of Aman is ordered to be impleaded as respondent No.3 in the main petition and amended memo of parties is taken on record. Registry is directed to tag the same at an appropriate place in the file.

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This petition has been filed under Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 seeking quashing of FIR No.18 dated 01.03.2023 under Sections 454/380 of IPC (Sections 420/34 of IPC added later on) registered at Police Station Talwara, District Hoshiarpur (Annexure P-1) along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 25.03.2023 (Annexure P-2).

Notice of motion for 11.02.2025.

At this stage, on the asking of the Court, Mr. Subhash Godara, Addl.A.G., Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.1-State and Mr. Mukesh K. Sharma, Advocate accepts notice for respondents No.2 & 3 and files his power of attorney and admits to the factum of compromise. Copy of the paper book be supplied to them during the course of day.

Service is complete.

In the meanwhile, the parties are directed to appear before the learned trial Court/Illaq Magistrate within two weeks from today or any other date convenient to the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate, to get their statements recorded regarding compromise and after recording their statements, learned trial Court/Illaq Magistrate is directed to send report regarding the genuineness of compromise and also to intimate whether any PO proceedings are pending against any of the party on or before the date fixed.

A copy of the order be sent to learned trial Court/Illaq Magistrate through fax for compliance. ”

3. In compliance of the aforesaid order, a report has been received from the concerned jurisdictional Court that the compromise between the parties is genuine and arrived at without any pressure or coercion from anyone.

4. In view of the compromise and the ratio of law laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in **Narinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another, (2014) 6 SCC 466**, and Full Bench of this Court in **Kulwinder Singh Vs. State of Punjab 2007 (3) RCR (Cr1.) 1052**, this petition is allowed and FIR No.18 dated 01.03.2023 under Sections 454/380 of IPC (Sections 420/34 of IPC



added later on), registered at Police Station Talwara, District Hoshiarpur (Annexure P-1) along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom are quashed, qua the petitioners.
