1. Instant appeal has been filed against the judgment and order, dated 20.03.2017 passed by learned Judge, Special Court, Sangrur, in case FIR No.199, dated 27.08.2013, under Sections 15, 61, 85 of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Sadar Dhuri, District Sangrur, vide which the learned Court has ordered for confiscation of oil tanker No.PB-19F-1006 by initiating separate proceedings.
