AMARJOT BHATTI, J.(Oral)

1. Petitioner Vishwas has filed petition under Section 483 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 seeking interim regular bail for 12 weeks in FIR No. 100 dated 02.04.2025 under Section 127(6), 96, 137(2), 61(2), 64(2)(m), 65(1) of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 and Section 4(2), 6, 17 of POCSO Act registered at Police Station Narnaud, District Hisar (Annexure P-1) on medical grounds.

2. Learned counsel for petitioner took the stand that petitioner is falsely implicated in this case. He has not committed any offence. Petitioner was arrested and is in judicial custody since 27.05.2025. Petitioner is facing serious multiple health problems. His personal profile is Annexure P-5, showing number of visits to hospital. Medical record of



PGIMS, Rohtak, Maharaja Agarsen Medical College and Hospital, Agroha and District Civil Hospital, Hisar are also annexed. It is prayed that petitioner may be granted interim regular bail on medical grounds so that he is able to take proper medical treatment.

3. Status report filed alongwith medical report signed by Medical Officer, Central Jail, Hisar (Annexure R-1). Again supplementary status report has been filed alongwith medical report with diagnosis. It is confirmed that petitioner is suffering from Depressive Episodes(F32) with Anxiety Neurosis, Anemia and Piles. It is further confirmed that on eight occasions, he was taken to General Hospital, Hisar on Emergency basis and on two occasions, he was taken to Maharaja Agarsen Medical College and Hospital, Agroha, otherwise, condition of patient is stable. He is referred time and again to concerned doctor for regular well-being, recovery and routine follow-ups.

4. I have considered the aforesaid factual position. Petitioner is behind the bars since 27.05.2025. As per custody certificate dated 05.11.2025, he is not involved in any other case. No doubt petitioner is being provided medical help by Central Jail, Hisar as and when required, but at the same time, it cannot be ignored that he is facing multiple health issues including suffering from Anxiety Neurosis. Considering the aforesaid factual position, for proper treatment of petitioner, his interim bail application is allowed for 15 days. Let, petitioner be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Judge concerned, who would also impose requisite conditions to ensure that temporary release is



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not misused.

5. Petitioner shall undertake to maintain peace and good behaviour during this period. He is directed to surrender before Central Jail No. 1, Hisar, Haryana on 26.11.2025 at 10:00 am sharp.

6. Petition is, accordingly, disposed of.

7. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, stand disposed of accordingly as well.
