MANISHA BATRA, J (ORAL):-

Through the instant petition under Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (for short 'BNSS'), the petitioners seek anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 03 dated 22.01.2025 registered under Sections 221, 132, 262, 191(3) and 190 of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 (for short 'BNS') at Police Station Sadar Gurdaspur, District Gurdaspur.

2. Vide order dated 29.10.2025 passed by this Court, the petitioners were released on interim bail and were directed to join investigation.

3. Learned State counsel filed status report dated 27.11.2025. The same is taken on record. She further, on instructions from ASI Malkeet Singh states that the petitioners No.1 and 4 have joined the investigation on 15.11.2025 whereas, the remaining petitioners have joined investigation on 17.11.2025 and they are not required for custodial interrogation.

4. In view of the fact that the petitioners have already joined the



investigation and the given nature of allegations, their pre-trial incarceration is not required. As such, without commenting on merits of case, it is observed that a case for release of petitioners on bail is made out. Accordingly, the petition is allowed and the order 29.10.2025 granting interim bail to the petitioners is made absolute, subject to compliance of conditions laid down in Section 482(2) of BNSS.

5. Since the main petition has been disposed of, pending application, if any, is rendered infructuous.
