SUBHAS MEHLA, J. (Oral)

1. The prayer in the instant criminal writ petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of directions to respondents No.3 & 4 to investigate into the complaint/representation (Annexures P-1 & P-2) submitted by the petitioner and to protect life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of respondent Nos.5 & 6.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that the eldest son of the petitioner namely Sukhpal Singh has fallen prey to the bad elements due to which the petitioner has disowned him long time ago. Now, in relation to said Sukhpal Singh, the police Officers of police Station Civil Lines Sirsa and Mehatpur are raiding the house of the petitioner time and again and as such, harassing and humiliating the petitioner and her husband with regard to FIR No.286 dated 03.08.2025 under Sections 21-C, 27-A and 29 of NDPS Act, 1985 registered at Police Station Sadar Fatehabad & FIR No.455 dated 26.09.2025 under Section 21-C of NDPS Act, 1985 registered at Police Station Civil Lines Sirsa, Haryana. He submitted that representations (Annexure P1 & P2), in this regard, have been moved by the petitioner to respondent No.2-Senior



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Superintendent of Police (Rural), Jalandhar & Superintendent of Police, Sirsa respectively, but it went in vain. Learned counsel also submitted that the petitioner would be satisfied if directions be issued to concerned respondent(s) to look into the aforesaid representation(s) and to take appropriate steps at the earliest.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Anup Singh, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent No.1-State of Punjab and submitted that the concerned authorities will take action on the representation, in accordance with law.

5. Mr. Aditya Pal Singla, AAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.2-State of Haryana and submitted that respondent No.4 will take action in accordance with law on representation moved by the petitioners.

6. Heard.

7. Keeping in view the contentions of learned counsel for the States of Punjab & Haryana, the present petition is disposed of, with a direction to respondents No.3 & 4 to look into the matter and take action in accordance with law. However, in case, the grievance on behalf of the petitioner still persists, the petitioner is at liberty to avail legal remedy available to them, in accordance with law.

8. Disposed of.
