1. The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of Bhartiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.169 dated 13.09.2024 registered under Sections 13, 3, 67 of The Punjab Gambling Act, 1867 and Sections 112, 304 191(3), 190 of The Bhartiya Nyaya Sanhita (BNS), 2023 and Section 25 of Arms Act, 1959 at Police Station Gate Hakima, District Amritsar.
2. By virtue of order dated 11.12.2024, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join the investigation.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation and fully cooperated with the same and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.
4. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Sakattar Singh has stated that the petitioner has affirmed the fact that he has joined the investigation and he is not required for further investigation.
5. In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 11.12.2024 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) of Bhartiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023.
