1. The instant petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India read with Section 3(1)(d) of the Haryana Good Conduct Prisoners (Temporary Release) act, 1988, for quashing of order dated 11.11.2024 (Annexure P-3) passed by respondent No.3 whereby the case of the petitioner for releasing him on parole, has been declined. The petitioner is also seeking directions to the respondents to release the petitioner on parole for 10 weeks.

2. Reply by way of affidavit of Sumit Panwar, Deputy Superintendent, District Jail, Faridabad, has been filed in the Court today which is taken on record subject to all just exceptions. A copy of the same has been supplied to the counsel opposite.

3. Learned State counsel submits that the instant petition has been rendered infructuous as the petitioner already stands released on parole during pendency of the appeal which is pending adjudication



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before Hon'ble the Apex Court.

4. In the circumstances, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the instant petition.

5. Dismissed as not pressed.
