AMARJOT BHATTI, J.

Petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 of BNSS, 2023 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.502, dated 27.10.2024, under Sections 115(2), 351(2) (5), 89 and 3 (5) of BNS, 2023 registered at Police Station Sadar Yamunanagar, District Yamunanagar (Annexure P-1).

2. As per facts of the case, the prosecutrix gave her statement that she is a house wife. On 21.10.2024, she was staying in her in-laws house village Tigri and she was three months pregnant. After marriage, her mother-in-law and other members of in-laws' family were not having good behaviour towards her. On 21.10.2024, she was sweeping in the house at about 10.00 a.m. and her husband had gone out for his work. Her mother-in-law Sushma and sister-in-law Sakshi started abusing her and gave her fist blows, her brother-in-law Subham also gave kick blows on her abdomen. She called police by dialing 112. In the meantime, her sister-in-law and brother-in-law ran away and her mother-in-law also went out from the house. The matter was reported to the police. She was taken to Civil



Hospital Yamunanagar for treatment. On 25.10.2024, she again faced health problem and was admitted in the hospital and eventually suffered miscarriage on 26.10.2024. With these allegations, present FIR has been registered.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner argued that in pursuance of previous order dated 19.02.2025, she has already joined the investigation and is not required for any other purpose. She is still ready to abide by the terms of bail order. No recovery is to be effected from her. It is submitted that her anticipatory bail application may be allowed.

4. Status report already filed. It is pointed out that medical treatment record of the prosecutrix is already collected. Shubham co-accused was arrested on 29.10.2024. Present petitioner is his wife. It is conceded that she has already joined the investigation and on the instructions of SI Lakhwinder Singh, it is pointed out that she is not required for any other purpose.

5. Considering the aforesaid factual position, no purpose would be served by sending her behind the bars. She has joined the investigation and fully cooperated with the investigation agency. Therefore, at this stage, without expressing my mind on the merits of the case, interim bail already granted by this Court on 19.02.2025 is confirmed subject to the same terms and conditions as envisaged under Section 482 (2) BNSS, 2023.

6. Petition is, accordingly, allowed.

7. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, stand disposed of accordingly as well.
