MAIN CASE

Challenge in the present petition is to the order dated 14.11.2023 passed by respondent No.3, order dated 11.03.2022 passed by respondent No.4 and the order dated 15.03.2022 passed by respondent No.6, to the extent it had the effect of posting the petitioner in Gurgaon Division.

Even though there has been a written request for adjournment circulated on behalf of counsel for the petitioner, however, from a perusal of the abovesaid prayer clause, it is evident that the petitioner has challenged her transfer orders whereby she has been transferred to Gurgaon Division.

Whereas, on the other hand, learned arguing counsel for the respondents has apprised this Court that the respondent-Authorities have compulsorily retired the petitioner from service; and as such, the present petition has become infructuous.

In view of the above, the instant petition is hereby disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.

Liberty is, however, granted to the petitioner to seek revival of the instant petition in case any of her grievance(s) remains unresolved.

All other misc. application(s), if any, also stand(s) disposed of accordingly.
