On request of learned counsel for petitioner, file is taken up for hearing out of turn.

Learned counsel for respondent No.2 appeared and filed power of attorney through Registry, which is taken on record. He pointed out that matter has been compromised between the parties. Learned counsel representing petitioner also confirmed the said compromise. It is pointed out by both counsel that parties have filed petition seeking divorce under Section 13-B of Hindu Marriage Act.
