1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 of B.N.S.S with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to him in case FIR No.300, dated 10.07.2024, under Sections 419, 420, 417, 120-B of IPC, registered at Police Station Zirakpur, District SAS Nagar, Mohali (Annexure P-1).

2. During the course of hearing today, learned counsel for the petitioner has handed over a demand draft of Rs.2 lacs to the learned counsel appearing on behalf of the complainant and the photocopy of the same has been taken on record as "Mark A". Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that in compliance of the order dated 20.01.2025 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

3. Learned State counsel also submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for further investigation.

4. In view of the above statement made by learned counsel for the parties, the interim order dated 20.01.2025 is made absolute. The petitioner shall continue to join the investigation, as and when called by the InvestigatingOfficer. The petitioner shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 482 (2) of B.N.S.S.
