The petitioners have filed the present petition under Section 482 of B.N.S.S with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to them in case FIR No.438, dated 28.11.2024, under Sections 115 (323 IPC), 190(149 of IPC), 191(2) (148 IPC), 333 (452 IPC), 351(3) (506 IPC) of BNS, registered at Police Station Bhuna, District Fatehabad (Annexure P-1).

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submit that in compliance of the order dated 13.12.2024 passed a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court, the petitioners have joined the investigation.

2. Learned State counsel also submits that the petitioners have joined the investigation and are no longer required for further investigation.

3. In view of the above statement made by learned counsel for the parties, the interim order dated 13.12.2024 is made absolute. The petitioners

shall continue to join the investigation, as and when called by the Investigating Officer. The petitioners shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 482 (2) of B.N.S.S/438(2) of Cr.P.C.
