What propelled the petitioner to approach this Court, by filing the instant motion is the indolent and lackadaisical attitude of the authorities concerned, as despite issuance of *Sanad Taksim*, vide order dated 18.2.2023, by the learned Assistant Collector, Ist Grade (Naib Tehsildar), Faridkot, no action has been taken, as on today.

2. Therefore, this Court, at this stage, without issuing notice to the private respondents, deems it appropriate to pass a mandamus upon the official respondent No.2, to take appropriate steps and proceed further with the partition proceedings, to its logical end, in case, there is no other legal impediment.

3. In view of the above, the instant petition is **disposed of** accordingly. Needful in the matter be done within a period of six month from today, on receipt of certified copy of this order.
