1. The petitioners have filed the present petition under Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 with a prayer to quash the cross case DDR No.27 dated 18.04.2016 (Annexure P-2) under Sections 325, 323, 148, 149, 506 of IPC at Police Station Division No.6, District Police Commissionerate, Ludhiana in case FIR No. 62 dated 17.04.2016 (Annexure P-1) registered under Sections 452, 323, 324, 148, 149, 506 of IPC, at Police Station Division No.6, District Police Commissionerate, Ludhiana (Subsequently, Section 452 IPC was deleted and Section 325 IPC has been added) on the basis of the compromise between the parties.



2. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Onkar Singh submits that the police had arrayed six accused in the present case, whereas the present petition has been filed only on behalf of five accused and in view of the law laid down by a Division Bench of this Court in the matter of ***“Rakesh Dass and others Vs. State of Haryana and another”*** decided on 12.11.2024, the present petition is not maintainable before this Court.
3. Faced with the above, learned counsel for the petitioners wishes to withdraw the present petition, at this stage.
4. Dismissed as withdrawn, at this stage.
