1. Prayer in the present writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus for directing respondent No.2 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and his family members from the hands of respondent Nos.4 to 8.

2. Reply by way of an affidavit dated 06.01.2025 of Vineet Ahlawat, IPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police, East, Amritsar City on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3-State has been filed and the same is taken on record.

3. Learned State counsel refers to Para No.13 of reply and submits that the threat perception of the petitioner and his family members was dispassionately examined and as per the report of the jurisdictional police officer, the petitioner and his family members are not facing any danger at the hands of respondent Nos.4 to 8. Further, the representation dated 04.11.2024 (Annexure P-3) has not been received in the concerned branch of office of the Commissioner of Police, Amritsar. Learned counsel furthermore submits that

the allegation against ASI Narinder Singh for pressurizing the petitioner to effect compromise with the private respondents is false and the aforementioned police official is not posted at PS B-Division, Amritsar.

4. In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition as the same has become infructuous.
5. Dismissed as withdrawn as having been rendered as infructuous.
