The petition has been filed, *inter alia*, seeking a writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents no.1 to 5 to protect the petitioner's life and liberty, as he is apprehending threats from respondent no.6, who is a former MLA of the area.

2. Learned State counsel has referred to the status report dated 08.03.2025, which is to the following effect:

7. That taking into consideration the allegations levelled by the petitioner that there is a threat to his life and liberty, one security personnel has been deputed with the petitioner. Furthermore, so as to avoid any untoward incident and taking into consideration the threat to peace and security, Kalandra u/s 126/129 BNSS, 2023 was prepared vide DDR No.26 dated 05.03.2025 against Respondent no.6 Joginder Pal and the same stands presented before the Ld. SDM.

He submits that adequate protection has been given to the petitioner to take care of the apprehended threat to his life and liberty.

3. In view of the aforementioned facts, learned counsel for the petitioner has no objection to the petition being disposed of in terms thereof.
4. Ordered accordingly.
