YASHVIR SINGH RATHOR, J. (Oral)

1. Prayer in this petition filed under Section 528 of Bharatiya
Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 is for quashing of F.I.R. No.117 dated
21.06.2019 registered under Sections 325, 323, 506, 34 of IPC (Section 308
of IPC, 1860 deleted and Section 307 of IPC added later on) at Police
Station Nathana, District Bathinda and all consequent proceedings arising
therefrom on the basis of compromise.

2. Reply dated 14.07.2025 already filed by the State in the
Registry in the form of an affidavit of Ravinder Singh, PPS, Deputy
Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division Bhuchio, District Bathinda, which is
taken on record.

3. This Court vide order dated 07.01.2025 had directed the parties
to appear before the Trial Court/Illaq to get their statements recorded and



the learned Magistrate was directed to send his/her report qua the genuineness of the compromise.

4. Pursuant to the aforesaid order, parties have appeared before learned Additional Sessions Judge, Bathinda and got their statements recorded. On the basis of the statements so recorded, learned Additional Sessions Judge has submitted report dated 21.01.2025 to the effect that the compromise has been effected between the parties voluntarily and without any coercion or undue influence.

5. Learned State counsel as well as learned counsel for respondents No.2 & 3 have not disputed the factum of compromise between the parties.

6. In view of the above, no useful purpose would be served to continue with the proceedings before the trial Court in the instant F.I.R. following the principles laid down by the Full Bench judgment of this Court in *Kulwinder Singh and others Versus State of Punjab and another* 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052 and approved by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in *Gian Singh Versus State of Punjab and others* (2012) 10 SCC 303, this petition is allowed and the FIR and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise qua the petitioners, are hereby quashed.

7. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
