HARKESH MANUJA J. (Oral)

1. Learned counsel for the respondent submits that in terms of orders dated 17.01.2025, 07.02.2025 and 13.02.2025; third bore-well has been installed within the premises of the petitioner-Society and the same is now functional.

 Learned counsel further submits that the necessary connection qua the third bore-well shall be approved/sanctioned in favour of the petitioner-Society, upon completion of all necessary formalities and the needful shall be done within two weeks from today and, thereafter, the bore-well shall be officially handed over to the petitioner-Society for all

intents and purposes.

2. In view of the aforesaid undertaking, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the present petition.
3. Dismissed as not pressed. Rule stands discharged.
4. However, in case the needful is not done, as per undertaking or the petitioner is aggrieved of the flow and strength of water from the bore-well, it be at liberty to seek revival of the present contempt petition.
5. Pending miscellaneous application, if any, shall also stands disposed of.
