The present petition has been filed under Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 seeking quashing of complaint under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act and subsequent proceedings filed by the respondent before the learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Panipat (Annexure P-1) against the petitioner i.e. NACT No.999 of 2015 dated 04.09.2015 in view of Memorandum of Understanding-cum-Compromise dated 10.11.2023 (Annexure P-5).

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the conviction of the petitioner was affirmed by this Court on 19.09.2023 in CRR-2041-2023 (Annexure P-4). The offence under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act is compoundable and after dismissal of the aforementioned criminal revision petition, the parties have amicably settled the dispute and the petitioner has already paid the entire amount to the respondent, as such, he seeks permission to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file an appropriate application in the aforementioned criminal revision petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty aforesaid.
