1. Keeping in view the reference received from the District and Sessions Judge, Kapurthala regarding unwelcoming and unruly conduct of Mr. Deepak Sidana, Advocate, District Courts, Jalandhar Enrol No.P/65/1988, s/o Late Sh. Kashmiri Lal r/o House No.330, Chotti Baradari, Part-1, Garha Road, Jalandhar, notice was issued to him.

2. Mr. Deepak Sidana, Advocate has filed an affidavit dated 25.01.2025 in which, he has regretted the incident that he has tarnished the reputation of the Court concerned due to his conduct and has further tendered unconditional apology for misdemeanour and transgression with the further undertaking that no such mistake will be repeated in future.

3. Mr. Deepak Sidana, Advocate appearing through virtual mode submits that he has highest regard for the Judicial Officer and henceforth as

well he will conduct the Court in a manner required and further states that for the last more than one year, he is appearing before the said Officer without there being any further incident and prays that his unconditional apology be accepted.

5. Keeping in view the said fact, once, the incident has been regretted by the respondent-Mr. Deepak Sidana and an unconditional apology has been tendered with a further undertaking not to repeat the same, the proceedings are closed against respondent/contemnor Mr. Deepak Sidana.

6. Accordingly, the present contempt petition stands disposed of.
