1. Present petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India read with Section 528 BNSS, seeking quashing of impugned order dated 06.08.2024(P-5) passed by respondent No.1, whereby prayer for grant of premature release has been rejected and deferred for one year despite fulfilling the conditions mentioned in the premature release policy dated 13.08.2008 (P-4).

2. On 17.12.2024, following order was passed:

“ Petitioner has filed the present petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India read with under Section 528 BNSS (earlier Section 482 Cr.P.C.) for quashing the impugned order dated 06.08.2024 (Annexure P-5) passed by the respondent No.1, whereby his prayer for premature release has been declined and deferred for 1 year despite fulfilling the conditions mentioned in the premature policy dated 13.08.2008 as he has already served 16 years of actual sentence and around 21 years of total sentence.

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Notice of motion.

On asking of this Court, Mr. Rupinder Singh Jhand, Addl. A.G. Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of State.

Adjourned to 23.01.2025.

Status report be filed by the respondent-State by the adjourned date.”

3. Today, at the very outset, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits that petitioner has already been released from jail, and on that count, present petition can be disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.

4. In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioner, present petition is disposed of as infructuous.
