SHEEL NAGU, CHIEF JUSTICE

1. The instant review application seeks review of the final order dated 12.11.2024 passed in CWP-PIL-220-2024, whereby this Court disposed of the said writ petition on finding that the prayers contained in clauses (ii), (iii) and (iv) had become infructuous due to subsequent developments having taken place during pendency of the said writ petition. The said writ petition was thus disposed of expressing hope and expectation that the Bar Council of Punjab and Haryana, which is seized of the matter, shall decide the complaints against respondents No.5 and 6 as expeditiously as possible.

2. The review that is sought herein relates to causes which arose to the petitioners after the order under review was passed, thus, does not lie within the review jurisdiction of this Court.



3. More so, petitioners No.1, 2, 3 and 5 have also filed fresh writ petition, i.e. CWP-PIL-281-2024, qua the subsequent cause of action.
4. In view of aforesaid, this Court finding no palpable error declines interference in this review application and disposes of the same with liberty to petitioners No.1, 2, 3 and 5 to pursue their fresh causes in CWP-PIL-281-2024.
