GURVINDER SINGH GILL J. (ORAL)

1. The instant petition has been filed seeking extension of parole as granted to the petitioner from 21.10.2025 up to 08.11.2025, which was subsequently also extended by this Court. The extension is mainly sought on medical grounds. Pursuant to directions issued by this Court, learned State counsel has today filed a report of the Board of Doctors, which had examined the petitioner. The report reads as under:-

“Today after receiving blood test reports and MRI report which shows spondylosis of lumbar spine with diffuse disc bulges at L-4 L-5 & L-5-S1 intervertebral disc levels with neural compromise at L-4 L-5 level.

Board is of the opinion that he needs complete bed rest for four to six weeks and medical treatment to recover his present condition.”



2. While we do find that the petitioner is having some issues in the nature of spondylosis and has been advised bed rest for four to six weeks, apart from some medical treatment so as to enable him to recover from his present condition but no such immediate surgical intervention or any such medical procedure has been advised.
3. In view of the aforestated position, we do not find any ground of extension of parole, the prayer for the same is ***declined***. However, the Superintendent, New District Jail, Nabha, is directed to ensure that the petitioner gets complete bed rest for atleast six weeks and is also provided with medical treatment as may be required. If necessary, he be also taken to any specialized hospital.
4. Disposed of accordingly.
5. Pending application(s), if any, also stand disposed of.
