1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to him in case FIR No.0072 dated 13.02.2024, registered under Sections 406, 420, 120-B of IPC, at Police Station Sector-8, Faridabad.

2. On 19.12.2024, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner had made a statement that he was ready and willing to return the entire amount of Rs.40.50 lacs to the complainant and he may be granted some time to make such a huge payment. It was further submitted that the petitioner would make the payment of Rs.10 lacs in favour of the complainant, on or before 15.01.2025 and he was clear the remaining entire amount within next three months, by making payment in equal installments.

3. Thereafter, the matter was taken up on different dates, however, no payment was admittedly made by the petitioner. It appears that the petitioner

had made a false averment before this Court, in order to obtain favourable order in his favour.

4. Consequently, the present petitioner is not entitled to the discretionary relief of anticipatory bail and the present petition is ordered to be dismissed.

5. Ordered accordingly.
