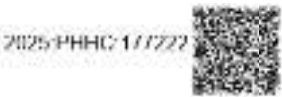

AARADHNA SAWHNEY, J. (ORAL)

Petitioner has filed the present petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying for issuance of writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus directing the official respondents to get detinue (wife of petitioner) be released from the illegal custody of respondents No.3 to 5.

Detinue, namely, Jashanpreet Kaur, aged about 19 years, is present today in Court. She has again been questioned in presence of both the counsels in open Court and she has reiterated her stand to stay with her parents.

It needs to be mentioned here that on 14.11.2025, when she was produced in the Court, she had been questioned when she had stated that she had been misguided by petitioner and that she wants to stay with her parents. On the



said day, on the request of counsel for petitioner, the case was adjourned as an argument had been put-forth that detainee is under the influence of her parents.

It has been more than one month since then and detainee has reiterated her stand, which has been noted hereinabove.

In view of the statement made by detainee - Jashanpreet Kaur, who is a ‘Major’, the instant petition is disposed of as such.
