1. In the present writ petition, the petitioners have challenged order dated 09.09.2025 (Annexure P-16) whereby, the claim of petitioners for regularization has been rejected. The petitioners have also challenged the advertisement dated 12.04.2025 (Annexure P-12).

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners submits that a similar issue came up for consideration before the Co-ordinate Bench of this Court in **CWP No.26899 of 2025 titled as 'Nishi and another Vs. Panjab University and others'** and the Co-ordinate Bench has allowed the above said writ petition vide judgment dated 06.11.2025. He further submits that as his case is similar, the present writ petition may also be disposed of in terms of **Nishi and another's** case (supra).
