JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioner through instant petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to the respondents to consider her claim as per Rule 5 of Haryana Government Compassionate Assistance Rules, 2006 (for short '**2006 Rules**').

2. The petitioner claims that she is widow of Mehtab Singh who passed away on 06.12.2013 in harness. The deceased employee was working with respondent No.3 as a Braceman. The respondent after the death of petitioner's husband appointed her as Sewadar for a period of 6 months. The said period was extended for a period of three years. The respondent has discontinued petitioner on the ground that the Center where the petitioner was deployed stands closed.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner does not claim compassionate appointment, however, she is entitled to

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financial assistance as per 2006 Rules. She has filed representation with the respondents but to no avail. The grievance of the petitioner, at this stage, would be redressed if the respondents are directed to consider and decide her representation.

4. Notice of motion.

5. Ms. Rajni Gupta, Additional Advocate General, Haryana, who on advance notice is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondents and waives service.

6. With the consent of both sides, the case is taken up for final adjudication.

7. Learned State counsel assures the Court that case of the petitioner would be considered and decided in accordance with law.

8. In the wake of statement of both sides, the instant petition stands disposed of with a direction to the respondents to consider claim of petitioner in accordance with law within three months from today.
