1. Present criminal writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India read with Section 3 of the Punjab Good Conduct Prisoners (Temporary Release) Act, 1962 for issuance of writ in the nature of certiorari to set aside the impugned order dated 28.10.2024(P-1) passed by respondent No.2. Further seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus, directing the respondents to release the petitioner on parole for 08 weeks.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that, in view of the order of even date passed in CRM-31573-2024 in CRA-S-3889-2023, whereby the prayer for suspension of sentence of the petitioner has been allowed, present petition has been rendered infructuous.
