1. This Court vide order dated 10.01.2025, had passed the hereinafter extracted order:-

“Through the instant petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, prayer is made for issuance of mandamus upon the respondents, to assess, and to further award the compensation to the petitioner on account of death of her husband due to electrocution, as per Clause 11 of the Policy dated 15.07.2019 (Annexure P-5), which relates to the electrocution incidents/accidents, both fatal and non-fatal, as well as in view of the judgment dated 21.02.2024 (Annexure P-8), passed by this Court in CWP-26327-2023.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that a representation dated 27.08.2024 (Annexure P-4), with regard to the claim of the present petitioner is pending consideration before respondents authority concerned.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Bhupender Singh, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of all the respondents, and waives service.

He seeks time to file a response to the instant petition. Adjourned to 24.04.2025.

The competent authority amongst the respondents, is directed to make its all endeavours to take final decision on the representation (supra), within a period of 03 weeks from today, and a copy of the decision, so taken, shall be placed on record, positively, on or before the next date of hearing.

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In case the compliance of the aforesaid direction is not made, the official respondent of the authority concerned, shall cause their personal appearance before this Court, on the next date of hearing.”

2. In deference to the directions (*supra*), today, learned State counsel, informs this Court that the authority concerned, has passed a speaking order on dated 06.05.2025 on the representation of the petitioner dated 27.08.2024 (Annexure P-4), and has placed on record a copy thereof. The same is ordered to be taken on record as Annexure 'A'.
3. The order (*supra*), reflects that the compensation amount has already been disbursed to the present petitioner.
4. Since the grievance of the petitioner, as incapsulated in the instant petition, has already been redressed, therefore, the instant petition, has been rendered infructuous.
5. **Dismissed** as having been rendered infructuous.
