Vide this common order, this Court intends to dispose of all the above-said petitions, as a common question of law is involved therein. For brevity, the facts are being taken from CWP-4737-2025.

1. The jurisdiction of this Court has been invoked under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of an appropriate writ, order or direction, especially in the nature of certiorari quashing the impugned final result dated 05.02.2025 (Annexure P-8) which has been issued without following the due process of law and is full of irregularities and illegalities; further a writ in the nature of mandamus be issued constituting an independent committee for checking the answer sheets of the petitioners including others in order to assess possibility of illegality in checking of the answer sheets; further a writ in the nature of mandamus be issued directing the Respondent Commission to declare category wise detailed result; further a writ in the nature of mandamus be issued directing the Commission to recheck and re-evaluate the answer sheets of the petitioners of the subject knowledge test against Advt No. 16/2024, in view of the fact that the petitioners performed very well during the examination, whereas the marks seems to be awarded arbitrarily; further a writ in the nature of mandamus staying the process of joining of the selected candidates during the pendency of the present writ petition.

2. Learned counsel appearing for the respondent/HPSC submits that, in compliance with the order dated 31.10.2025, speaking orders dated 15.12.2025 have been passed in all the above-said petitions. Copies of the same have been furnished to the opposite counsel. The same are taken on record.

3. In light of the above, nothing survives in the present petitions.

4. However, the petitioner(s) shall be at liberty to assail the speaking orders dated 15.12.2025 by way of fresh writ petitions, if so advised.

- 5. The question qua relaxation in disability, as involved in CWP-827-2025, shall remain open for adjudication in any subsequent writ petition, if the petitioner chooses to file a fresh petition challenging the aforesaid speaking order.
- 6. Accordingly, all the above-said petitions are disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
- 7. Pending application(s), if any shall be disposed off.
- 8. A copy of this order be placed on the file of other connected case file.
